Brief Description of Services			

Dewberry will provide architecture, structural, civil, plumbing/fire protection, mechanical, electrical, and technology services for the design development thru contract administration services for the Henry-Stark Counties Special Education District #801 Wings Academy.

#### Project Assumptions:

- Design Deliverable drawings and narratives dated 5.27.2025 shall be furthered through this DD-CA contract.
- Project will be bid to a general contractor.
- Project does not have a sustainable objective or LEED goal for the project.
- Construction cost estimate limited to updating the SD estimate at 95% design.
- AE shall apply for building permit and NPDES Permit as required
- Construction site visits limited to once a month (12 total in basic services), visit each month shall be the pay request review meeting.
- Construction phase services which include submittal review, RFI's, and review of pay applications.

If the services covered by this agreement have not been completed by 9/31/2026, through no fault of the Architect, extension of the Architect's services beyond the time shall be compensated as additional services.

# Project Scope:

Included in our proposal for architecture, structural, civil, plumbing/fire protection, mechanical, electrical, and technology services for the design development thru contract administration services for the Henry-Stark Counties Special Education District #801 Wings Academy.

# Deliverables include the following (PDF-format digital deliverables):

- Two (2) Design Meetings
- Design Development Drawings for review and approval
- 95% cost estimate
- 95% Construction Documents for review and approval prior to bidding
- Sealed Bid and Permit drawings and specifications in pdf format.

#### Exclusions

- Additional renderings
- Unless noted otherwise, items indicated in Attachment C are excluded from the scope of work. Proposal includes interior design services, however furniture design/documentation, move management are excluded.
- Preparation of utility easement plats, if required.
- Design, construction, permitting, and coordination services associated with improvements to City of Kewanee infrastructure including street improvements, sanitary sewer improvements, and potable water system. This exclusion includes any and all coordination with the Illinois Department of Transportation. It is assumed that all improvements to City of Kewanee infrastructure will be designed, coordinated and permitted by the City of Kewanee.
- Landscape design including selection of plants/trees, site furnishings, etc
- Smoke and Flame generation modeling and testing/special inspections is excluded from this contract. If Smoke Evacuation is required for this project, Dewberry Engineers Inc shall receive recommendations from an external consultant (fee not included). Design of Smoke Evacuation System is included, if required, after receipt of information

from a fire consultant.

- All changes after final CDs may necessitate additional fees unless they are a result of our errors or omissions.
- Multiple Bid Packages.
- Design of Support of Excavation, Sheeting, Underpinning, and the like.
- Seismic restraint of mechanical and electrical components and their associated distribution systems.
- Cold form metal framing design and detailing.
- Design of pile or deep foundation systems.
- Value engineering redesign after the schematic design approach has been established.
- Topographic or boundary survey will not be required (performed as part of Schematic Design Phase).
- Design of stormwater management infrastructure (i.e. stormwater detention basin) will not be required.
- **Electrical Exclusions:** 
  - 1. Power distribution to specialized equipment / systems.
  - 2. Power distribution to commercial kitchen equipment.
  - 3. Detailed short circuit current analysis, coordination study, and arc-flash analysis.
  - 4. Power to site electrical equipment (other than site lighting).
